



Pair of Tulip Pagodas

Materials

Slip decorated earthenware, underglaze, and overglaze enamel painting

Description

Each of the Tulip Pagodas consists of seven components: four tiered tower sections, one bowl, one cover, and a stand. The pagodas and stands comprise about two-thirds of the height of each. The pagodas themselves have figures depicted in architectural spaces. The pieces are decorated in salmon pink, periwinkle blue, mustard

yellow, amber, and white. The Tulip Pagodas also serve a functional purpose as a display container for the tulip with their pierced forms, which allows multiple tulips to be viewed simultaneously.
