Materials

Linen, gesso, pigment, gold leaf

Description

This lush fiber work is constructed of strips of woven linen with gesso, earth colored pigments and gold leaf applied to the surface. The central area of each separate piece has the image of a half circle (circulo in Spanish), which forms a whole circle when placed side-by-side. The architectural and sculptural tapestry udulates like liquid creating a play with light and dark.
