Description

Deconstructed and distorted American and Mexican flags - showing the red and white stripes and the white stars on blue of the American flag and the eagle, snake, and cactus of the Mexican flag - make up the majority of the fabrics in this piece. The color on the cloth is washed out. Intersecting across the work are barbed wires.
