Large trompe l'oeil carved wood sculpture resembling a stack of books sitting on a folded tablecloth over a surface with intricate Celtic knot ornamentation. Consists of seven books (Omnibus, Photography, Dictionary, Field Guide to Bats, Open Journal and Slipcovered Twins) - one vertical in

the rear, three stacked horizontally, two on the left leaning on the stack of three, and one in the front leaning back onto the three. Includes two hollow book boxes, containing a hand-bound photo album, which documents the process of putting the piece together, and a guest book for visitors to sign with their commentary.
